



Yorktown Offers FREE Outdoor Concerts All Summer Long

Yorktown's Sounds of Summer Concerts kick off Thursday, June 7, at Riverwalk Landing in Historic Yorktown. Opening the eight-week series is Slapnation, a local favorite who always delivers a high energy performance with a mix of Motown, beach music, and even a little disco. Summer concerts are 7 to 9:30 p.m. on Thursdays (with the exception of July 5) through the beginning of August. Come early and enjoy dinner at any of the waterfront restaurants including Water Street Grille, Riverwalk Restaurant, Carrot Tree, Umi Sushi, Yorktown Pub, and newly opened Larry's Alehouse & Deli.

This year's lineup is one of the most exciting yet, with three bands new to the series: Vinyl Headlights, Right On Band and En'Novation.

The concerts are performed on the performance stage at Riverwalk Landing overlooking the York River. There will be a dance floor, friendly games of Cornhole, and to-go food from Carrot Tree available for purchase. Guests are encouraged to bring their own blankets, chairs, and coolers. New this year will be a drawing at intermission for a prize package put together by York County, participating Historic Yorktown businesses and attractions, and some of the featured bands.
