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Upper Deck of Riverwalk Landing Parking Terrace Closing for Routine Maintenance

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Routine maintenance work on the upper level of the Riverwalk Landing parking terrace begins August 16 and is projected to be completed by October 1. Repairs to the parking terrace include application of a traffic-bearing membrane, installation of new expansion joints, replacement of sealants, repairing cracks in the concrete, and pavement markings and line striping. This work will also prevent any rain from leaking into the lower level. To maximize the lifespan of the repairs, work must be performed during moderate temperatures avoiding extreme heat, cold, wind, and moisture. The lower level of the structure will have limited parking during this time.

Beginning August 16, the Yorktown Trolley is expanding operations with a second trolley providing service seven days a week through Labor Day, and then on weekends throughout the completion of the project, to carry passengers to and from parking lots throughout town. To help direct visitors to free parking, attendants/ambassadors will be stationed at the parking terrace on concert evenings and weekends.

In order to assist with parking for the County's Thursday evening concerts, two trolleys will operate from 5 to 10 p.m. to carry concertgoers between Water Street and the parking lots located at County Administration and the York-Poquoson Courthouse, both located on Ballard Street. In addition, the American Revolution Museum at Yorktown is opening its lot to concertgoers who can ride a shuttle to and from the concert area.
