Street Closures and Trolley Route Schedule for Yorktown Day on Tuesday, October 19

October 12, 2021

Vehicular access to the following streets in historic Yorktown will be restricted to residents and their guests on Tuesday, October 19, from 10 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

- Zweybrucken Road (closed to vehicular traffic until 12:30 p.m.)
- Bacon Street (closed to vehicular traffic until 12:30 p.m.)
- Comte de Grasse (closed to vehicular traffic till 12:30 p.m.)

The Yorktown Trolley will deviate from its normal route to accommodate the patriotic exercises commemorating the 240th anniversary of the American and French Revolutionary War victory at Yorktown. The trolley will run from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. following this schedule:

- 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. – National Park Service Visitor Center to the American Revolution Museum at Yorktown via Ballard Street to Water Street and return via Water Street and Ballard Street.
- 1 to 5 p.m. – (Returns to normal route) National Park Service Visitor Center to the American Revolution Museum at Yorktown via Zweybrucken Road, Comte de Grasse Street and Water Street and return via Water Street and Ballard Street.
